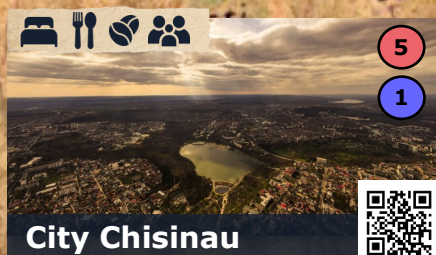
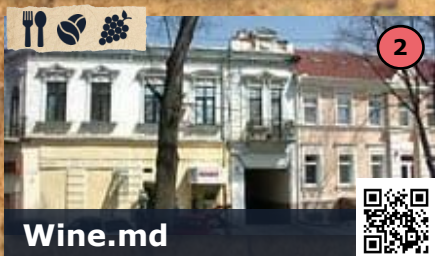

The first coffee shop in the world opened in Constantinople in 1475, named Kiva Han and become very soon a popular gathering place for men to socialize. 1640 in Venice, the first coffee house in Venice was named Alla Venezia Trionfante, it exists also nowadays, since 1720 under the name Caffé Florian. In 1644 Pasqua Rosée introduced coffee to Paris. In the UK first coffee house was opened in Oxford in 1650 at a location now known as The Grand Café In London 1652, Pasqua Rosée's Café opened in St. Michael's Alley.
